“When the new studios of the National Broadcasting Company in the RCA Building in Radio City were designed, special provision was made for dramatic programs. In fact, so definite was the provision for drama that one of the largest studios was named for one of radio’s outstanding dramatic groups, the Radio Guild.

The Radio Guild studio was built especially for the broadcasting of dramatic programs and is constructed and fitted like a small theatre. The actual broadcasting studio is the stage area, the rest of the room being filled with regular theatre seats.”
